


FEMA Flood Zones

FEMA Flood Zones

- 0.2 PCT flood hazard has an annual chance of being equalled or exceeded in any given year
- 0.2 PCT flood hazard has an annual chance of being equalled or exceeded in any given year, but is CONTAINED in channel
- A - 100 Year floodplain (determined in the FIS by approximate methods)
- AE - 100 Year floodplain (determined in the FIS by detailed Methods)
- AH - 100 Year shallow flooding (usually areas of ponding) where average depths are between 1 and 3 feet
- AO - 100 Year shallow flooding (usually areas of sheet flow on sloping terrain) where average depths are between 1 and 3 feet
- X - 500 Year floodplain and 100 year flooding where average depths are less than 1 foot
