State Route 32 Widening Project (Phase 2) Update

Introduction

Following is the construction update newsletter for the SR32 Widening Project (Phase 2). The purpose of these updates is to share detailed information regarding schedule and construction activities anticipated for the upcoming week(s). Temporary Traffic Signals, Barrier Rail, Restriping and Traffic Shift

The Contractor will be mostly working at night to remove existing concrete splitter islands, place concrete barrier rail (k-rail), place delineators and restripe the roadway to shift lanes and align traffic into stage construction configuration. Temporary traffic signal equipment installation is being completed to control traffic throughout project construction. It is anticipated that the temporary signals will be activated and the existing signals will be deactivated. Motorist will be directed to the temporary signals once the existing signals are deactivated and signal heads covered.

Minor traffic delays should be expected. Access to all residences and businesses within the construction zone will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. Please be sure to travel through the area with caution, paying attention to revised traffic alignments, signing and devices. Other safety tips include:

- ✓ Drive slowly and carefully through the construction area.
- ✓ Be alert for construction workers and large equipment, such as backhoes, graders and trucks.
- ✓ Obey all construction signs and directions from traffic control flaggers.

The City appreciates your patience and understanding during the project. Please feel free to contact City staff or the Contractor should you need additional information. The Contractor will notify residents & businesses prior to the commencement of any construction activities that may affect or is in the immediate vicinity of their property.
