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STATE ROUTE 32 WIDENING PROJECT PHASE 2

Beginning in July, and continuing through January 2017, Knife River Construction will be performing construction along State Route (SR) 32, from the SR99 / SR32 Interchange east to the easterly Park and Ride Lot.

Phase 2 of the SR32 Widening Project consists of construction of safety and circulation improvements to bicycle, pedestrian, vehicle, and transit facilities on SR32, from State Route 99 to east of the Park and Ride lots where the project will conform to the recently completed Phase 1.

Phase 2 consists of installation of new traffic signals at the Fir Street intersections with SR32; modification of existing traffic signals at the SR99 on and off ramps; installation of a Class I bike path and a Class II bike lane along Fir Street; installation of curbs, gutters, sidewalks, curb ramps and landscaping; and modifications to the existing transit and Park and Ride facilities.

Local access throughout the project construction zone will be subject to traffic controls and temporary delays to accommodate construction crews and equipment. You are encouraged to build extra time into your schedule or plan alternate routes to avoid the project area if possible. The City realizes this will pose a temporary inconvenience and appreciate your cooperation and patience during this time. Residents and businesses will have access to their properties at all times.
