### **ITEMS NOT APPEARING ON THIS AGENDA**

*This Agenda was posted on the Council Chamber Bulletin board at least 72 hours in advance of this meeting. In order for the Committee to take action on an item not appearing on the posted agenda, other than merely acknowledging receipt of correspondence or other information, the Committee must make one of the following determinations:*

- 1) *Determine by a two-thirds vote, or by unanimous vote if less than two thirds of the Committee is present, that the need to take action arose subsequent to the Agenda being posted.*
  - 2) *Determine that the item appeared on a posted agenda for a meeting occurring not more than five calendar days prior to this meeting, and the item was continued to this meeting.*
1. **LEAGUE OF AMERICAN BICYCLIST - BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY APPLICATION** - Staff will provide status of application.
  2. **CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE - BICYCLE FACILITIES** - City staff will provide an update to the committee on all bicycle-related projects under or nearing construction.
  3. **ED MCLAUGHLIN MEMORIAL CONSIDERATIONS** - Staff will solicit input from the committee on ways to commemorate one of Chico's greatest bicycle advocates.
  4. **BICYCLE PLAN UPDATE** - Staff will solicit input from the committee on updating the 2007 Bicycle Plan, to prepare the plan for Council review, in order to continue the City's eligibility for future grant funding.
  5. **SUNRISE COURT BIKE PATH** - Request from Mechoopda Indian Tribe of Chico Rancheria to abandon Sunrise Court Bike Path, a connection from Elm Street to East 20<sup>th</sup> Street, due to health, safety, and welfare of the public. Staff is requesting a recommendation from the BAC, which will be forwarded to the City Council, in conjunction with the abandonment request.
  6. **BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR** - A member of the general public may address the Committee on any matter not appearing on the agenda which is of interest to such person and which is within the jurisdiction of the Committee. Where a member of the general public seeks to address the Committee under Business From the Floor, the Committee may ask questions of such person but may not discuss the matter unless and until the matter is included on a posted agenda at a subsequent meeting, or one of the above determinations is made.
