Dear Debbie,

At the July 20, 2016 Arts Commission meeting, you indicated that we should submit a request for an allocation of city funds for the much needed maintenance of the "Our Hands" Sculpture. We were directed by the Commission to submit a proposal for discussion at the October 19, 2016 Arts Commission meeting.

The Chico Arts and Culture Foundation has obtained a scope of work and bid from Select Janitorial Services (SJS) for completing the project. This includes stripping, cleaning, patching, polishing and sealing the terrazzo sculpture. We felt very fortunate to find this local company through the Museum of Northern California Art who highly recommended them after SJS refurbished the terrazzo floor in the Veterans Memorial Building on the Esplanade.

The estimate is \$4928.00 which included all materials, labor, and fence rental. It will take six days days to complete.

Thank you very much for your assistance in this matter and for all your help to date in keeping the Arts Commission viable. We could not do it without you!

Scope of Work

Refurbish the "Hands" sculpture

- Strip Existing Sealer
 - Place protective covering on concrete surrounding hands
 - Apply stripping solution and agitate with hand pads
 - Extract/rinse stripping solution with truck mount high pressure, hot water, rinse and extraction system
- Patch holes and voids
 - Will utilize an two part epoxy compound and color match as close as possible
- Polish Stone
 - Will utilize diamond polishing pad to restore luster to the stone
 - 200 Grit first step
 - 400 Grit final step
- Clean stone post polishing
 - Will utilize stone cleaning solution as a final clean in preparation for sealing
- Seal Stone
 - Will apply two coats of Tesco Crystal Sealer (Artists original sealer)

Description of Work

We are estimating that this entire project will take approximately 6 days from start to finish. The "hands will be surrounded with temporary fencing and the concrete surrounding the sculpture will be protected as best as possible. Original sealer will be stripped, holes patched, and stone polished per artists original specs. The "hands" will then be cleaned in preparation for application of the sealer. The "hands" must be completely dry for sealer to be applied and only one coat of sealer can be applied in a 24 hour period. We will use Tesco products as this was what was originally used by the artist.


