Summary of Stakeholder Concerns Identified at Stations

Chico Unified School District

- ◆ Student parking at Chico High.
- ◆ North/south path through Chico High campus.
- ◆ Staff parking at Citrus Elementary; pedestrian safety.

Chico State

- ◆ Incentives for students, faculty and staff to use alternative transportation and reduce automobile use.
- ◆ E/W and N/S bike routes through campus.
- ◆ Better circulation/coordination with other agencies.

Alternative Transportation

- ◆ Improve bus routes and schedules (i.e., smaller buses running shorter routes more often).
- ◆ Improve bike paths and connections through Chico State and Chico High.
- ◆ Improve bike safety, in general (both physical and educating cyclists and motorists).

Chico Avenues Neighborhood Association

- ◆ Bike safety/bikeability.
- ◆ Street lighting.
- ◆ Parking management (code enforcement, impacts of commuter parking).

Enloe Medical Center

- ◆ Parking for visitors/patients.
- ◆ Incentives for employees to use alternative modes.
- ◆ Integrate TDM with Planetree effort and partner with CSUC.

City of Chico

- ◆ Enforcement of speeding, scofflaw bicyclists.
- ◆ Parking management.
- ◆ Connectivity of bike paths.
