Stakeholder Group Top Priorities

Cycling/Alternative Modes

- Bicycle and pedestrian Bridge: Where and what does it connect to?
- Provide bike/ped connectivity to other areas.
- Maintain the natural corridor as much as possible.

Neighborhood Residents

- Reduce homeless camping in Comanche Creek area.
- Create an open passive park.
- Encourage bike and pedestrian access and discourage car access.

Employers/Employees

- Connections to improve circulation and access for all modes (ped/bike/vehicle).
- Create passive recreation opportunities throughout Comanche Creek property.
- Encourage additional development to create additional employment in this area.

Environmentalists

- Emphasize passive use.
- Protect and restore natural resources.
- Quantify environmental and aesthetic benefits of any circulation.

Schools/Youth

- Environmental education (outdoor classroom), emphasizing appreciation, understanding, stewardship.
- Safety—access by walking, biking, by car.
- Access to nature for community enhancement.

Landowners/Developers

- Connect E. Park and Otterson in the least intrusive, most direct manner.
- Encourage redevelopment of creekside properties for services and “eyes on the creek.”
- Areas for passive park with active use areas
