COMPLETION OF LINDO CHANNEL PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PROJECT

The City of Chico is pleased to announce the completion of the Lindo Channel Bicycle Bridge Rehabilitation Project at Ceres Avenue. The 302-foot long bridge is located at the southern end of Ceres Avenue between Manzanita and East Lindo Avenues. The bridge provides a critical link along the City's Bikeway 99 route and serves as an important high water crossing over Lindo Channel for both bicycles and pedestrians.

Project elements included bridge deck replacement and public safety improvements. Specifically, the existing wood decking was replaced with lightweight reinforced concrete decking. Low-level bridge lighting, as well as two streetlights, one at each end of the bridge, were installed. For added public safety, security cameras, similar to those along the bike path between CSU, Chico and the railroad grade, will be installed on the new street light poles in coming weeks.
