The City of Chico Invites You to Participate!

The California State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted the Statewide Trash Amendments (Trash Amendments) in 2015. As a result, the City of Chico (City) needs to comply with the Trash Amendments by implementing one of two types of plans:

Track 1: Install, operate, and maintain Full Capture Systems (FCS) within the storm drain system for all Priority Land Uses within the City's jurisdiction.

Track 2: Install, operate, and maintain any combination of Full Capture Systems, Multi-Benefit Projects, other Treatment Controls, and/or Institutional Controls within the City's jurisdiction.

Based on preliminary analyses, the City selected Track 1 and submitted the required information to the State Water Board. By December 1, 2018, the City needs to submit updated information and maps identifying:

- The storm drain network;
- Priority land use areas discharging to the storm drain network;
- Proposed locations of the certified FCS; and
- Proposed equivalent alternative land uses (if any).

In order to provide key opportunities for public engagement and input during the development of the December 1, 2018 Trash Master Plan submittals, the City is holding a public stakeholder meeting. General topics to be covered during this meeting include:

- Background and introduction to Statewide Trash Amendments;
- Mapping of jurisdictional Priority Land Uses; and
- Implementation Plan for Track 1.
