SUSPECT: David Larry Huff, 66 yrs old, Cottonwood resident

NARRATIVE:

On the above date and time, Chico Police responded to an armed robbery that had just occurred at the Umpqua bank, 2025 Pillsbury Rd. Officers responded to the scene and were advised that the suspect had fled the business on foot. An extensive search of the area was conducted but the suspect was not located.

During the investigation, officers learned that the suspect entered the business and handed a teller a note demanding money. The note also indicated that the suspect was armed with a gun, although a gun was ever seen. The suspect fled the business on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash.

The suspect was described as a white male, 55-65 yrs. old, with a thin build. The suspect had gray hair and a mustache. He was wearing jeans, a black coat, and a black hat.

******UPDATE******

As the investigation continued, Chico Police Department received numerous anonymous tips with possible suspect information. One of the tips identified David Huff as a possible suspect. During the investigation, Chico PD Detectives obtained evidence linking David Huff to the bank robbery and obtained a warrant for his arrest. On 10-28-15, Chico PD Detectives, with the assistance of two Chico PD TARGET Officers and Tehama County Sheriff Deputies, contacted David Huff at his residence in Cottonwood and arrested him without incident. David Huff was booked into the Butte County Jail on a single charge of bank robbery.
