TYPE OF INCIDENT: Stabbing / 245(a)(1) P.C., Assault with a deadly weapon

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: 500 block of Nord Ave

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: 2-7-15 / 2154 hours

INCIDENT CASE NUMBER: 15-0790

VICTIM: White male adult / 21 years old

SUSPECT: Hispanic male adult, 5'7", heavy build, dark hair pulled back into a ponytail, wearing black shorts with a red T-shirt.

NARRATIVE:

On 2-7-15 at approximately 2154 hours the Chico Police Department received a 911 call of a possible stabbing that had just occurred in the 500 block of Nord Ave. According to the caller, a white male adult was reported to have been stabbed during an altercation with another male subject.

Officers arrived on scene and located the victim with several stab wounds to the left side of his torso. The victim was taken to a local hospital where he was immediately taken into surgery due to his injuries.

According to witnesses, the suspect was last seen running into an apartment complex located in the 700 block of Nord Ave. Officers completed an area check for the suspect with negative results.

The suspect was described as a Hispanic male adult between the ages of 19 and 22 years old. He was approximately 5'7" tall and had a heavy build. His hair was dark in color and was pulled back into a ponytail. The suspect was wearing black shorts with a red colored T-shirt.
