**TYPE OF INCIDENT: Carjacking**

### **NARRATIVE:**

On 08/17/15 at about 0820 hours, officers responded to a carjacking that had occurred near the intersection of Madrone Avenue and Vallombrosa Avenue. An adult female was pushed from her Subaru Outback by 30 year old suspect Barry Xaysana. The victim female sustained minor injuries to her wrist and arm as she resisted the theft of her vehicle. A Chico Fire engine was in the area and observed the incident take place. An additional vehicle, described as a silver Honda was seen in the area and believed to be associated with the suspect. Both the victim vehicle and the silver Honda fled the area after the incident. Descriptions and license plate numbers were broadcast to responding officers and allied agencies. At about 0830, a CHP officer observed the stolen Subaru parked, unoccupied behind the Boot Barn on Esplanade. Additional officers from Chico Police arrived in the area and questioned witnesses. Xaysana was located by officers in the bathroom of Jack in the Box across the street. Xaysana was in possession of property belonging to the victim. He was identified by the victim as the individual who stole her vehicle.

Aside from the victim, there were no additional injuries as a result of this incident. No weapon was mentioned or seen by the victim or witnesses. Officers are still looking for a silver 2012 Honda Accord Ca. plate 7ABV895 driven by a blonde female adult. The driver of this vehicle is possibly associated with this incident. In addition, this vehicle is reported stolen out of Chico.
