Narrative:

On September 15th, 2015 at about 0410 hours, Chico Police responded to a vehicle burglary in progress. A Chico resident called 911 because he looked out his front window and saw an unknown subject moving around the inside his car. Officers arrived in the area and found the suspect still inside the vehicle. When Officers contacted the suspect, he fought with them and fled on foot. Officers gave chase and the suspect failed to stop. A Police K-9 was deployed and caught the fleeing suspect. Once on the ground, the suspect kicked the K-9 while trying to escape. Officers were able to arrest the suspect and positively identified him as Anthony Beck (7-4-94). Beck, who had extensive criminal history, was treated and released from a local hospital. The vehicle Beck was found in had a broken shaved key in the ignition. Beck was out of jail on O.R. (Own Recognizance) for other felony charges to include stolen vehicle. Beck was charged with attempted stolen vehicle, resisting arrest, assault on a police dog, and committing a felony while out on bail. Beck was transported to Butte County Jail.
