TYPE OF INCIDENT: Fatal Collision and Suspect DUI

LOCATION: 1075 E. 20th St. Chico, CA

DATE/TIME: Thursday, October 1st 2015

On 10-1-15 at about 0140 hrs, The Chico Police Department responded to the scene of a single vehicle roll over collision in the area of Sierra Nevada Brewery, 1075 E. 20th St. When Officers arrived on scene they discovered that a silver Toyota Camry, being driven by Andrew Reenan (age 21), was traveling westbound when it collided with the center median. The vehicle appeared to have struck shrubs and trees in the median and rolled over. The rear passenger in the vehicle (identity withheld pending notification of next of kin) was a 19 year old female Chico resident. The right front passenger, Tyler Burns (age 19), also sustained major injuries and was transported to Enloe Hospital where he remains in critical condition. At the conclusion of an investigation the driver (Reenan) was arrested on suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol that resulted in bodily injury and vehicular manslaughter. Reenan was booked into the Butte County Jail; his bail has been set at \$225,000.

All lanes of E. 20th St. between Martin Luther King Boulevard and C Street will remain closed for several hours following this press release as officers are still on scene documenting the collision.
