TYPE OF INCIDENT: Attempted Robbery

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: Salvation Army, 700 Broadway Street, Chico

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: 12-3-15 / 1820 hours

VICTIM: Salvation Army / Two employees

SUSPECT: A white male adult, slender build, between 5'10" and 6' tall, wearing dark clothing.

NARRATIVE:

On 12-3-15 at approximately 1820 hours, the Chico Police Department dispatch center received a call of a possible robbery at Salvation Army located at 700 Broadway Street. Two employees were leaving the business at closing when they were confronted by the suspect inside the business. The suspect was brandishing a knife and demanded "the money" from the employees. One of the employees threw a can of tea at the suspect causing him to back away from them momentarily. The employees were able to retreat into another room and lock the door. A search of the business was completed and the suspect was not located inside the building or in the area.
