TYPE OF INCIDENT: Drive-by shooting / Assault with a Deadly Weapon

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: Intersection of E. 16th Street and C Street / 873 E. 16th Street

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: 1-31-16 / 2058 hrs.

INCIDENT CASE NUMBER: 16-0787

VICTIM: 17 year old victim

SUSPECT: Heavy set males in a white smaller sedan with tinted windows.

NARRATIVE:

On 1-31-16 at approximately 2058 hours the Chico Police Department received a 911 call advising of a shooting that occurred in the area of E. 16th Street and C Street. The caller stated one subject had been shot and was near the Dorothy Johnson Center located at 775 E. 16th Street. Units were advised the suspect may have left in a white colored sedan last seen traveling eastbound on E. 16th Street.

Officers arrived on scene and located a 17 year old victim near the Dorothy Johnson Center who had been shot in the foot. The victim had a single gunshot wound and was taken to a local hospital for treatment. His wound was not life threatening.

According to the involved parties, the victim had just left a residence in the area when the suspect vehicle drove past him. The vehicle then turned around when the driver and front passenger began shooting at the victim. The victim attempted to flee but was struck in the foot by one of the bullets. The vehicle was described as a white four door sedan with tinted window. The only description of the driver and passenger were heavy set males. Officers attempted to locate the vehicle and or suspects in the area with negative results.
