TYPE OF INCIDENT: Domestic violence, stabbing, evading an officer

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: 1443 Yosemite Drive, Chico

NARRATIVE:

On 3/26/16 at approximately 2021 hours, the Chico Police Department received a 911 call of a domestic dispute where the victim was stabbed. The victim, William A. Oiler, advised he had been stabbed on the left side of his body by his girlfriend. According to the victim, the suspect, Daun Slagle, left in a gray Nissan Altima sedan traveling southbound on Yosemite Drive toward Hwy. 32.

Officers responding to the scene observed the above vehicle near the intersection of Bruce Road and Picholine Drive. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, however, it continued southbound on Bruce Road. The vehicle then turned westbound onto E. 20th Street with officers pursuing her. The vehicle eventually turned into the Winco Foods parking lot, located off E. 20th Street, where the vehicle was stopped. The suspect was taken into custody at this time.

The victim was transported by ambulance to a local hospital for a single stab wound to the left side of his rib cage. The wound was not life threatening and the victim was treated and released from the hospital.

The suspect was arrested for 245(a)(1) P.C., assault with a deadly weapon, 273.5 P.C., domestic battery, 2800.1 VC, evading an officer, and 273.6 P.C., restraining order violation. She was booked at the Butte County Jail on the above listed charges.
