SUSPECT: William Forward of Chico (Age 24) and David Milliron of Clearlake (Age 25)

NARRATIVE:

The victim was riding his bicycle into the south One Mile Recreation Area when a vehicle pulled up behind him and began honking its horn. The victim waved for the vehicle to pass him. Words were exchanged between the occupants of the vehicle and the victim. Two occupants of the vehicle exited the vehicle and assaulted the victim. The victim's phone was forcibly taken from him during the assault.

Responding CPD officers were alerted by witnesses to a vehicle leaving the area. Officers stopped the vehicle in the area of Sycamore St. and W. 8th St. All occupants of the vehicle were detained and the suspects, Forward and Milliron, were identified by the victim and a witness. Both subjects were ultimately booked into Butte County Jail and the other occupants of the vehicle were released after providing statements.

The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment for his injuries. He is expected to make a full recovery. His phone was also recovered. The intersection at W. 8th St. and Sycamore St. was shut down during the vehicle stop, but it was re-opened after a few minutes.
