**NARRATIVE:**

On Friday, May 13, 2016 at about 2:35 p.m. Chico Police Dept. received a report of a 14 year old, male suspect distributing Oxycodone prescription medication tablets to other students on the Chico Jr. High School grounds from campus officials.

More than five students were identified as having received Oxycodone from the suspect. One student was transported to a local prompt care facility while another student was transported to a local hospital via ambulance for medical treatment as a result of ingesting the drug.

The suspect was arrested and transported to Butte County Juvenile Hall on felony charges of Furnishing a Schedule II drug and endangering a juvenile in a manner likely to cause great bodily harm. The other juveniles identified as having been in possession of the drugs will face charges through the Butte County Juvenile Probation Office for possession of a Schedule II drug.
