**LOCATION OF INCIDENT:** Alba Avenue at the bicycle path, Chico

**SUSPECT:** Joshua Pennock, 28 year old male, transient, Chico

**NARRATIVE:** On 06/11/16 at approximately 1238 hours, Chico Police were called to a reported stabbing in the area of Alba Avenue and the bicycle path. Officers arrived and located a male suffering from a single stab wound to his upper body. Witnesses reported a male suspect had fled the area, riding a bicycle southbound along the bicycle path. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he was treated and released. Officers checked the area and located Joshua Pennock on Parmac Road and Rio Lindo Avenue. Pennock was identified by the witnesses as the suspect responsible for the stabbing. Pennock was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and booked at the Butte County Jail.
