NARRATIVE:

On 6/29/16 at about 8:30 p.m. Chico Police Officers were dispatched to a reported hit-and-run incident at the intersection of E 19th St and Park Ave, Chico. It was later determined, Price had been driving a vehicle eastbound on E 19th St and collided with a bicyclist. Price fled the area in his vehicle.

Officers located the vehicle being driven by Price near Boucher St and Cleveland St. Officers attempted to stop Price, but Price fled from officers in his vehicle. Officers pursued Price and stopped him at the intersection of E 10th St and Bartlett St.

Price was booked on felony charges of DUI resulting in injuries to another, hit-and-run resulting in serious injuries and evading with wanton disregard for the safety of others.

The victim was transported to a local hospital where he is listed in stable condition.
