TYPE OF INCIDENT: 496PC – possession of stolen property, probation violation, violation or O/R terms.

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: 3761 Esplanade, Chico

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: 07/1/16 22:00 hours

INCIDENT CASE NUMBER: 16-4935 (related to commercial burglary 16-4750)

VICTIM: Urban Laundry - 222 Main Street, Chico.

SUSPECT: Robert Standard (07/30/80)

NARRATIVE:

Officers on routine patrol initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle driven by Robert Standard. Officers recognized that 18 Nixon brand watches in Standard's possession appeared to match those reported stolen by Urban Laundry staff on 06/25/16. The watches in Standard's possession were brand new, and most of them still had their UPC tags attached.

CPD dispatch was able to make contact with Urban Laundry staff. Staff responded, and were able to identify the watches as 18 of the over 3 dozen Nixon watches stolen during the commercial burglary.

Due to the high value of the recovered watches, Standard was arrested for the felony section of stolen property possession. He was also arrested for violating his Butte County Probation terms, and violation of the terms of his release from Butte County Jail on his own recognizance (O/R). After booking, Standard was sent to Butte County Jail. Standard's bail was \$30,000.
