**NARRATIVE:**

On 07/13/16 Officers from the Chico Police Target team arrested 47 year old Jeffrey Rosandich and 26 year old Kayla Philbrook in the parking lot of the Quality Inn located at 715 Main Street in Chico. Both Rosandich and Philbrook were identified as Chico residents with felony warrants for their arrest. Target officers observed Rosandich and Philbrook getting into a vehicle parked in the hotel parking lot and contacted them to confirm their identity. As an officer was detaining Rosandich, a loaded semi-automatic pistol was located in his possession. Upon discovery of the firearm, a brief struggle ensued between the Rosandich and the officer. Rosandich was quickly detained in handcuffs without further incident. Philbrook was detained without incident. Both Rosandich and Philbrook were positively identified as wanted for felony warrants in Butte County and arrested.

Rosandich was arrested for the following charges:

- Felony warrant for narcotics sales
- Possession of a loaded firearm in commission of a felony
- Felon in possession of a firearm
- Narcotics sales and possession

Philbrook was arrested for the following charges:

- Felony warrants for violation of post release supervision (PRCS)
- Misdemeanor warrant for narcotics possession
- Providing false information to an officer
- Possession of narcotics
