NARRATIVE:

On 09/29/16 at about 12:30am Chico Police Officers were involved in a pursuit with a van driven by 37 year old Chico resident Chase Forcier. Forcier was known to be wanted for a felony warrant and other felony crimes including vehicle theft and forgery in Butte County. The pursuit began after an officer attempted a traffic stop on the van for a vehicle code violation in the area of Cussick Avenue and Henshaw Avenue. The van initially stopped then fled leading officers on a pursuit at speeds of 70 miles per hour. The pursuit was called off for concerns of public safety when officers observed the van driving the southbound in the northbound lanes of Esplanade. Officers lost sight of the vehicle but located it a short time later unoccupied and parked in the 300 block of W. 4th Avenue.

Later that morning, the Chico Police Target team located Forcier in a residence on the 300 block of W 4th Avenue. Forcier was taken into custody without incident. Officers also arrested 45 year old Chico resident Nick Sanchez and 26 year old Chico resident Arielle Zimmerman at the same residence for unrelated charges. Sanchez was arrested for narcotics possession and violation of probation. Zimmerman was arrested for an outstanding warrant.
