TYPE OF INCIDENT: Assault with a deadly weapon

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: In-N-Out Burger

SUSPECT: 15 year old male (Name withheld)

NARRATIVE: On the above date and time, Chico Police were called to In-N-Out Burger for a fight in the parking lot involving a baseball bat. Officers arrived and learned that the incident started in the Walmart parking lot. A 21 year old male allegedly stole a cellular phone and identification from a 29 year old female. The female was accompanied by another female and a 15 year old male juvenile. The juvenile went inside Walmart and purchased an aluminum baseball bat. The juvenile and two females returned to their vehicle and began to look for the 21 year old male. They found the 21 year old male in the parking lot of In-N-Out Burger. The 15 year old juvenile chased the 21 year old male and struck him multiple times with the baseball bat. Officers arrived and arrested the juvenile. The 21 year old male was transported by ambulance to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. A complaint will be submitted to the Butte County District Attorney's Office regarding the possible theft involving the 21 year old male. People are reminded to contact law enforcement authorities rather than taking matters into their own hands.
