NARRATIVE:

On 2-25-17 at around 2326 hrs, CPD received a call from a citizen near Chico Nissan Hyundai, 575 Manzanita Ave reporting hearing glass breaking at the dealership. At the same time, CPD received an additional call from a janitor inside the business reporting a suspect in the office taking keys to new vehicles. Several CPD units responded to the business, with the first police unit arriving within one (1) minute of the initial call. The suspect, however, was able to get into a new Nissan Frontier truck and flee the scene. Police units saturated the area in an attempt to locate the stolen truck.

During an area check, K-9 Officer D Ament located the occupied stolen truck at the intersection of E 1st Ave @ Mangrove Ave. He activated his overhead emergency lights and siren on his patrol unit, but the driver did not stop. The suspect fled down surface streets in a reckless manner without any regard for public safety, so the pursuit was canceled. The truck was last seen driving onto the southbound off-ramp of Hwy 99 @ Cohasset Rd.

Shortly after, a CPD officer spotted the truck near the intersection of East Ave @ Esplanade. The truck drove into a nearby field and crashed into a tree, injuring the solo occupant. The suspect, identified as 35 year old Ryan David Anderson from Redding, was taken into custody without further incident.
