Train vs. Pedestrian

Chico, CA – On 6/29/17, at approximately 2051 hours, Chico Police Officers were dispatched to the area of W. 4th Ave/ Railroad track for a possible Train vs. Pedestrian. Chico Fire personnel were first on scene and located the pedestrian on the west side of the railroad tracks near W. 4th Ave. Chico Police Officers arrived and conducted an investigation as the pedestrian was transported to Enloe Hospital for major injuries.

Officers later learned the pedestrian was conscious and talking. The pedestrian sustained major injuries but the injuries do not appear to be life-threatening. The pedestrian is a white female adult in her 20's. The name of the pedestrian will not be released at this time. The investigation is on-going.

Due to the combined efforts of Chico Fire Personnel, Butte County EMS, and Chico Police Officers, the pedestrian was able to obtain the medical attention needed.
