TYPE OF INCIDENT: Assault with a deadly weapon

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: Picnic tables near Sycamore Fields

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: 02-24-2015 / 0538 hours

INCIDENT CASE NUMBER: 15-1133

VICTIM: 20 year old male

SUSPECT: White male adult, early 20's, with a shaved head

NARRATIVE:

On 02-24-2015 at 0538 hours, Chico Police responded to a report of a stabbing in the 1000 block of Woodland Ave. The reporting party stated that an unknown female knocked on her front door and reported that her friend had been stabbed and that she needed help. The reporting party told the female that they would contact the police.

When officers arrived in the area, they contacted the female who directed them to a male subject at the picnic benches near Sycamore Field. The male victim was suffering from multiple, non-life threatening stab wounds to his upper torso. The victim was immediately transported to Enloe Hospital for treatment.

During the subsequent investigation, Officers learned that the incident occurred at the picnic tables. The victim indicated that he got into a physical altercation with a male subject who is known to him. During the altercation, the suspect retrieved a knife from his backpack and stabbed the victim multiple times. The suspect then fled the area in an unknown direction.

The victim in this investigation was not cooperative and did not want to participate in a police investigation. The victim refused to identify the suspect.
