The project involved installing self-contained safety cameras along the bike path, from Big Chico Creek to West Sacramento Avenue. The project also covers the CSUC bike path as it exits campus, crosses the city bike path, and ends on Nord Avenue. The camera system was designed to make the bike path a safer place to travel for students, citizens, and bicyclists through deterrence, identification of suspects, and evidence collection.
