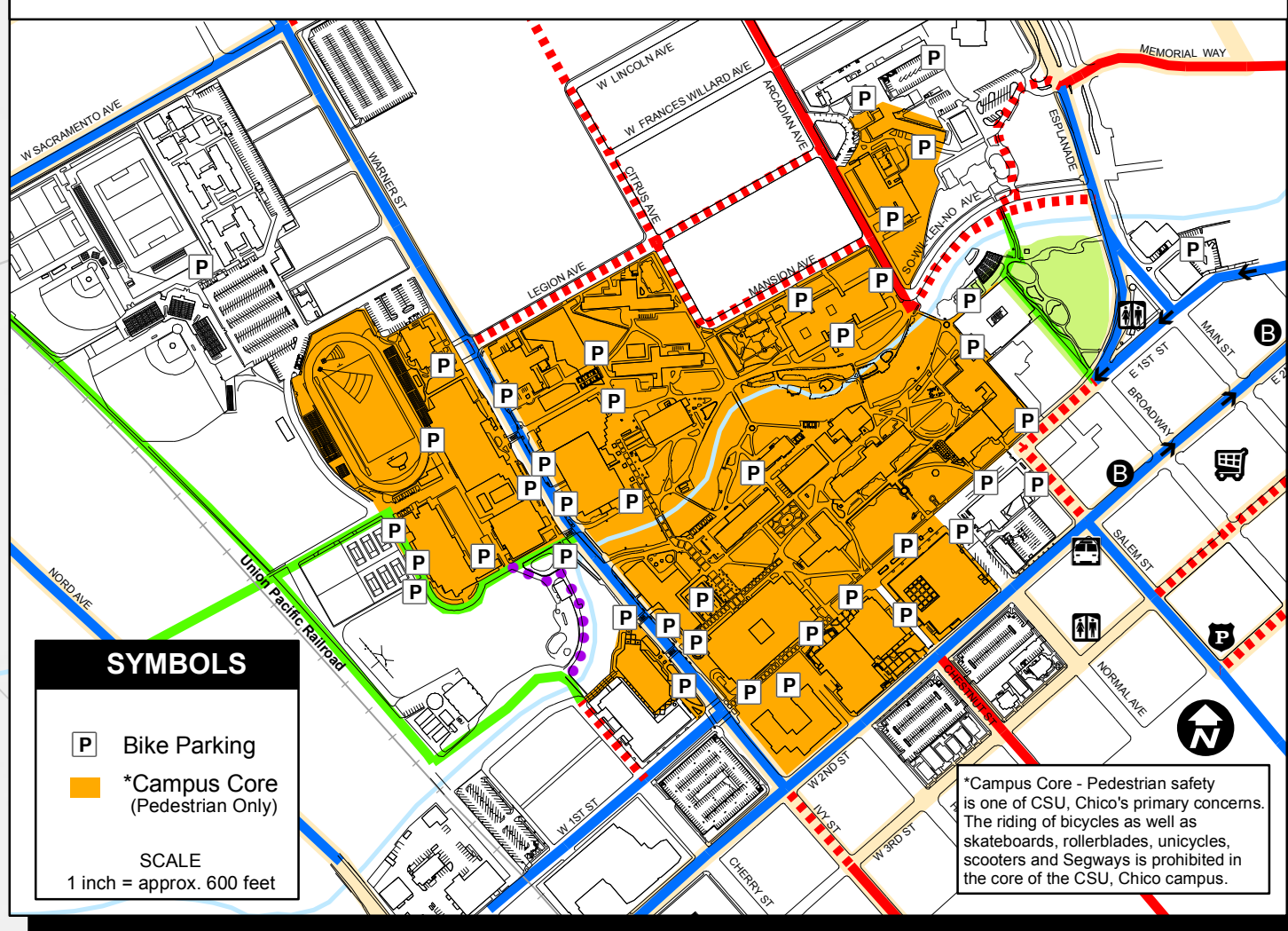

LEGEND

- Bike Paths (Class I)
Paths are separated facilities designed exclusively for the use of bicycles and pedestrians. May have minimal cross flow from motorists.
- Bike Lanes (Class II)
Lanes are restricted right-of-ways designed exclusively for the use of bicycles with vehicle parking and cross flows by pedestrians and motorists permitted.
- Bike Routes (Class III)
Lanes are restricted right-of-ways designed to provide shared use for bicycles, pedestrians, and motorists. Routes may be simply designated by a sign.
- - - Connector (Class IV)
Connectors provide links between paths, routes, and lanes. Connectors are unmarked and may not provide adequate space for bicycles, pedestrians, and motorists.
