## Hazards in the Home

## Look for these Hazards:

- 1. Improperly stored matches. Keep in fire-safe container and out of the easy reach of children.
- 2. Improper storage of any flammable materials (read the container for storage information and **never** store flammable materials in an unapproved container -- it's against the law!).
- 3. Improper use of gasoline as a cleaning fluid.
- 4. Improper use of fuses. Always replace blown fuses with the same size and **never** use an object other than a fuse to extend the life or bypass the use of a fuse!
- 5. Improper disposal of spray cans. Never discard in a furnace, incinerator, trash burner, or other fire.
- 6. Overloaded electrical outlets.
- 7. Frayed, worn, or otherwise expose wiring on electrical cords of any kind.
- 8. Unprotected fireplaces. Make sure that wood burning fireplaces have adequate fire screens.
- 9. Accumulation of trash and other burnables.
- 10. Careless storage of papers and other inflammable materials that can ignite by spontaneous combustion. Keep attics, basements, garages, and homes neat and tidy.
