CITY OF CHICO'S UPPER PARK ROAD TREATMENT PROJECT

CHICO, CA -- (July 3, 2024) – The City of Chico, in collaboration with Doolittle Construction, will start construction of the Upper Park Road Treatment Project on Monday, July 8, 2024. This project involves a cape seal treatment from the Manzanita roundabout to Lot E by Horseshoe Lake in Upper Bidwell Park, along with new striping and placement of pavement markings. Construction will take place Monday through Friday and is anticipated to be completed by early August.

Funding for this project is provided by local funds including Measure H, demonstrating the City's commitment to maintaining and improving infrastructure for the benefit of all residents.

Throughout the project, local access within the project construction zone will be managed with traffic controls in place to ensure safety for motorists and construction crews. Temporary delays may occur as crews and equipment maneuver through the area, with the possibility of one-lane traffic during certain phases of the project. Motorists are encouraged to plan routes accordingly, allowing for extra travel time or considering alternate paths if possible. The City appreciates the community's cooperation and patience during this time.
