## CITY OF CHICO TO HOST VIRTUAL URBAN FOREST SUMMIT

(Chico, CA – January 6, 2023) The City of Chico, in collaboration with the Butte Environmental Council, and Dudek, a leading multidisciplinary, environmental, and engineering consulting firm, today announced that it will host the second Urban Forest Summit. The Summit will be held online Thursday, January 12, 6-7:30pm.

The City's Urban Forest Master Plan will help guide decisions concerning the urban forest over the next 40 years. Summit organizers will lead community members through a series of guided discussions with a specific focus on the Strategic Plan element of the City's UFMP.

"The Strategic Plan component of the UFMP is where "the rubber meets the road" and will list the specific goals and actions over the next forty years as the City anticipates and reacts to climate-related issues, including increasing heat and drought severity," says Richie Bamlet, City of Chico Urban Forest Manager. "We look forward to meaningfully engaging with the Chico community on developing a thoughtful strategy to manage the City's trees today and ensure their health and longevity for the benefit of future generations."

The Urban Forest Summit is open to all and the city encourages participation by residents, business owners and anyone who wishes to be involved in planning for the City's Urban Forest.
