

## Amendment to the City of Chico's HUD 2019-2020 Annual Plan

This Amendment is to the City of Chico's 2019-20 Annual Plan that was approved by the Chico City Council on June 4, 2019 and submitted and approved by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). This amendment is to reflect the additional Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds of \$512,416 awarded to the City pursuant to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), signed by President Trump on March 27, 2020, and proposed allocation of a portion of these funds for FY 2019-2020. Program funds may be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus.

The Amendment reflects an allocation of **\$127,000** of the CDBG-CV funding to existing Public Service grantees to assist in their response to the COVID-19 pandemic during FY 2019-2020. Details are below:
