Updated 3rd Substantial Amendment to the City of Chico's HUD 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan

The proposed 3rd Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 HUD Annual Action Plan allocates \$533,312 for public services funding to a service provider to provide temporary sheltering services, including but not limited to: case management, wrap around services, outreach, hygiene services and provide food and supplies to homeless households who are vulnerable to COVID-19. The Amendment also allocates \$49,900 to Point of Contact to provide outreach and education to homeless households vulnerable to COVID-19. This is the final Substantial Amendment to the City's Annual Plan for the use of CDBG-CV (coronavirus) funding that was awarded through the CARES Act in 2020.
