

**2<sup>nd</sup> Substantial Amendment to the  
City of Chico's HUD 2019-2020 Annual Plan**

The 2nd Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2020 HUD Annual Action Plan allocates \$282,933 for public services funding to Chico Housing Action Team (CHAT) to provide a supportive housing program for homeless families who are susceptible to contracting COVID-19 through their master lease program. The proposed amendment also allocates the allowable set-aside (up to 20% of the total allocation) for Program Administration, \$167,285.
