Bruce Road Reconstruction Project (Skyway to State Route 32)

Monthly Update

Introduction

Following is the first in a series of monthly electronic updates that City staff will provide to property owners, businesses, interested organizations, and other stakeholders adjacent to the project. These updates will continue throughout the 2024 and 2025 construction seasons to share detailed information regarding the progress of the Bruce Road Widening Project (Skyway to State Route 32). Work Completed

Work on the Bruce Road Widening Project officially commenced on April 22, 2024, with implementation of traffic control measures for the first stage of the project, which includes a hard closure on Bruce Road between Skyway and E 20th Street, and a hard closure from Concord Ave to Banner Peak in preparation of removal and reconstruction of the bridge over Little Chico Creek. Roadway work



involved the removal of asphalt and excavation of the roadway between Skyway and E 20th Street in preparation for the new Roller Compacted Concrete (RCC) roadway. A new storm drain trunkline was installed from Fremont Street to Bruce Road along what will be the future "Webster Road", as well as completion of a new storm drain installed along Bruce Road between Skyway and E 20th Street. At the new bridge location between Concord Ave and Banner Peak,



where Bruce Road will be elevated approximately 4 feet, a new retaining wall has been constructed north of the creek on the east side of Bruce Road.



Work Planned for the Coming Month

In the coming weeks, work will continue on the roadway reconstruction with the installation of underground utilities. The roadway excavation will be completed and graded, and base rock will be placed to support the new roadway surfacing. New concrete curb & gutter and median curbs will be installed in preparation for the RCC paving. At Little Chico Creek, environmental clearance has been received to install a temporary creek diversion allowing work to begin on the new bridge. The area around the existing bridge will soon be cleared of vegetation, and following the creek diversion the existing bridge will be demolished and construction of the new bridge piers will begin.
