### Bruce Road Reconstruction Project (Skyway to State Route 32)

## Monthly Update

Introduction



Following is the latest in a series of monthly electronic updates that City staff provides to property owners, businesses, interested organizations, and other stakeholders adjacent to the project. These updates will continue throughout the 2024 and 2025 construction seasons to share detailed information regarding the progress of the Bruce Road Reconstruction Project (Skyway to State Route 32). #### **Work Completed**

Over the past month, substantial progress has been made on the Bruce Road Reconstruction Project. Most of the underground work between Skyway and E. 20th Street has been completed, including storm drains, waterlines, sanitary sewer, and electrical conduit for street lighting and traffic signals. A portion of the storm drain system near Raley Blvd

remains incomplete pending design changes required to address unknown utilities discovered during construction. Progress has also been made on soil replacement areas, with crews importing topsoil for the landscape medians and parkways. Work was also completed on the portion of Bruce Road between Banner Peak Drive and SR32, with the multi-modal path excavated and storm drain structures substantially completed.

Replacement of the bridge over Little Chico Creek is also making great progress. The bridge contractor installed the bypass at the beginning of June, allowing for in-channel work to begin. With the creek channel dewatered, crews have completed excavation and construction of the first of two spread footings, which will support the new bridge deck. Work continues excavating for the remaining footing and placement of reinforcing steel for the bridge columns.



#### **Planned Work**

In the coming weeks, underground utilities between Skyway and E. 20th Street will be finalized, and the contractor will begin the placement of base rock and installation of curbs and gutters. At the bridge, drilling for the abutment foundation pilings will begin, and construction of the remaining spread footing should be completed. Between Highway 32 and the new bridge, roadway work will focus on final roadway grading, placement of base rock, installation of curb and gutter, and import of topsoil for landscape medians.
