THE CHICO MUNICIPAL CODE (C.M.C.) CURRENTLY PROVIDES NO APPROVED METHOD FOR CONNECTING A NEW SEWER LATERAL TO AN EXISTING SEWER MAIN. THE FOLLOWING ARE THE APPROVED METHODS. A REVISION TO THE C.M.C. WILLBE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE NEAR FUTURE CODIFYING THESE METHODS.

Under no circumstances will products be accepted that project past the inner wall of the pipe.

Fernco Flexible Tap Saddles – Allowed for all diameters and types of pipe material. Pressure kit is required.

Romac Industries, Inc. Style "CB" Sewer Saddle. - Allowed for all diameters and types of pipe

material. Inserta Tee - Allowed for thick walled pipe (i.e. clay and concrete) with diameters of 15-

inches or greaterJM Eagle PVC Tees and Wyes - Allowed for P.V.C. pipe with diameters of 6-

inches through 12-inches.

Mission Rubber Company LLC T-Flex Sewer Saddle – Allowed for all diameters and types of pipe material.

Other products may be submitted to the City for consideration. However, the City reserves the right todevote as much time as it deems necessary to make the determination.

MATERIALS

Casting	The saddle body is cast from ductile (nodular) iron, meeting or exceeding ASTM A 536, Grade 65-45-12.

Pipe Stop	A pipe stop is molded into the inside wall of the gasket. This pipe stop can hold up to 1000 lbs of force along the branch.			
Strap	Type 304 (18-8) Stainless Steel, 3 1/2 inches wide to spread out clamping forces on the pipe. M.I.G. and T.I.G welds. Passivated for corrosion resistance.			
Bolts and Nuts	Type 304 (18-8) Stainless Steel, passivated for resistance to corrosion. 1/2" National Coarse roll thread. Nuts coated to prevent galling.			
Coatings	Shop coat applied to cast parts for corrosion protection in transit. Fusion bonded epoxy, liquid epoxy and other coatings available on request.			
Washers	Acetyl and stainless steel washers are used to reduce friction.			
PRESSURE RATING	Designed for sewer service, the Style CB saddle will hold a 7 psi air test when properly installed on a pipe within the correct outside diameter range.





Note: A pipe stop capable of withstanding 1000 pounds of thrust is molded into the CB saddle gasket. Care must be taken during system design and installation to assure that this thrust limit is not exceeded.

Scope

This specification describes 4- through 30-inch (100 to 750 mm) INSERTA TEE service connections for use in gravity-flow sewer and drainage applications.

Product Requirements

INSERTA TEE service connections shall consist of a PVC hub, rubber sleeve and stainless steel band. Connection shall be a compression fit into the cored wall of a mainline pipe. Hub shall be made from heavy-duty PVC material. Stainless steel clamping assembly shall be made from minimum 301 grade steel. Rubber sleeve and gasket, when applicable, shall meet the requirements of ASTM F477. Gaskets shall be installed by the manufacturer. The water-based solution provided by the manufacturer shall be used during assembly. Do not use pipe lube.

The INSERTA TEE can be installed into any mainline pipe or structure. Connection hubs are available to connect to: corrugated polyethylene, corrugated polypropylene, PVC C900, SOR 26 HWS, SOR 35 (gasketed bell, SWR spigot & solvent weld bell), IPS/Sch 40 (gasketed bell & solvent weld bell)and corrugated PVC. Custom pipe types available.



Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturer's recommended installation guidelines. Backfill around the INSERTA TEE service connection shall be of the same material type and compaction level as specified for the mainline pipe installation. APPLICATIONS

JM Eagle[™] offers a line of PVC SDR 35 sewer fittings to be used with PVC Ring-Tite[™] SDR 35 sewer pipe. Rubber "locked-in" gasketed Tee saddles and Wye saddles are available for field service line taps into previously installed PVC sewer lines, which minimize the need for field solvent welding. Through the large network of JM Eagle[™] distributors, adaptors are available to connect JM Eagle[™] Ring-Tite[™] PVC sewer pipe to other pipe materials. Products should be installed in accordance with JM Eagle[™] Publication JME-05B, "Ring-Tite[™] Gravity Sewer Installation Guide."





SHORT FORM SPECIFICATION

SCOPE

This specification designates general requirements for unplasticized polyvinyl chloride (PVC) Plastic Gravity Sewer Fittings with integral bell and/or spigot joints for the conveyance of domestic sewage in accordance with ASTM D3034.

MATERIALS

All fittings meet the requirements of ASTM specification D3034 for 4" through 8" SDR 35 and are listed to the Uniform Plumbing (U.P.) code. All fittings shall be made from virgin PVC compound and/or the manufacturer's own clean reworked material to provide physical and mechanical properties that equal or exceed cell class 12454 as defined in ASTM D1784.

FITTINGS

All fittings shall be suitable for use as gravity sewer con- duit. Provisions must be made for expansion and contrac- tion at each joint with an elastomeric ring. The joint design meets qualification requirements of ASTM D3212, under both 25 ft of head pressure and 22 in. Hg vacuum. All fit- tings and accessories are manufactured and furnished by the pipe supplier or approved equal and have bell and/or spigot configurations compatible with that of the pipe. Siz- es and dimensions shall be as shown in this specification. Pipe installation and usage shall be in compliance with the JM Eagle[™] Publication JME-05B, "Ring-Tite[™] Gravity Sewer Installation Guide."

DROP IMPACT TEST

Fittings are subjected to impact testing from a free falling Tup A (20-lb.) and flat plate holder B in accordance with ASTM method of test D2444. No shattering or splitting(denting is not a failure) that can be seen by the naked eye is acceptable when the impact energy is applied. Fittings are exposed to ongoing heat reversion tests as well.

PIPE LOAD SUPPORT

Fittings are subjected to this test requirement per ASTM Specification F1336. There shall be no cracking or separation of the fitting, and the pipe spigot shall not protrude into the waterway of the fitting.
