

## **City of Chico Plan Review Checklist**

# **Erosion and Sediment Control Plans for Residential** and Commercial Sites

This Checklist can be used as a guide for determining the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan (ESCP) submittal requirements for Residential and Commercial Permits. The guidance provided here is intended to outline the ESCP review process and does not constitute a review of the proposed erosion controls for a specific permit. Approval of the proposed erosion controls is at the discretion of the City of Chico Public Works Stormwater Department reviewer.

1.	The area of soil disturbance IS less than 1000 square feet?	Yes	No
2.	The site IS flat (less than 8% slope) prior to development project?	Yes	No
3.	There <b>IS</b> at least 50 feet to the nearest DI, canal, ditch, wetland, or water body?	Yes	No
4.	There will be <b>NO</b> heavy equipment used, stored, fueled and maintained on site?	Yes	No
5.	There will be <b>NO</b> chemicals, paints, or other hazardous materials stored on site?	Yes	No
6.	There will be <b>NO</b> concrete forming or finishing on this project?	Yes	No
7.	There is <b>NO</b> known soil contamination on the project site?	Yes	No
8.	Development project <b>WILL NOT</b> include off-site discharge or dewatering?	Yes	No
9.	The remaining (undeveloped) site area WILL remain vegetated?	Yes	No
10.	The total Soil Disturbance area IS LESS than 1 acre?	Yes	No

If "Yes" to all questions 1-10, an ESCP is not required. Please note that Section 15.50 of the City of Chico Municipal Code applies to all soil disturbing activities whether or not a permit or plan review is required.

If "Yes" to all questions 2-10, the 1-Page, Over the Counter ESCP Worksheet shall be submitted.

#### <Over the Counter ESCP Worksheet>

If "No" to one or more of questions 2-9, the 6-Page ESCP Worksheet is required.

<6-Page ESCP Worksheet>

If "No" to question 10, the project is required to submit a SWPPP to the California SMARTS website and provide the City with a valid WDID number.
