


- 1. On March 25, 2021, Scott Steele notified me that he intended to buy Hangar A-1 from Norm Nielsen, Chico Electric immediately.
- 2. The lease with Norm Nielsen, Chico Electric is the standard ABC row hangar lease. It has an initial term of one year and will automatically extend for successive one-year terms unless either party gives a least a 90-day notice of termination. The rent will be per the Airport Fee Schedule, currently \$556.48 per year, with annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustments.
- 3. The lease states that upon termination or expiration of this lease by expiration of the lease term or legal process and provided Lessee has not renegotiated a new lease with the City or removed its hangar from the lease premises, Lessee shall be responsible for removing all hangars erected on the leased property, all at Lessee's sole cost and expense. Provided that if, on the 90th day following the termination or expiration of this lease, a hangar remains on the leased property, then such hangar shall thereafter, at the election of the City, become the property of City without legal notice or the payment of any compensation therefor and City may thereafter further lease for its own account or dispose of the hangar in any manner at its sole discretion.
- 4. In accordance with AP&P 90-16: The assignment of any lease, shall be reviewed and approved by the Commission prior to execution by the City Manager.


CHICO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT
GENERAL AVIATION HANGAR ROWS





CONSIDERATION OF LEASE ASSIGNMENTS APPROVAL CHANGE

REPORT IN BRIEF:

Current practices for any new or routine lease assignment for hangars in rows A, B, and C approval has come from the Airport Commission through the use minute orders. Staff and Commissioners have realized a need for the approval of these lease assignments to occur in a timelier manner. The change of hangar ownership for hangar rows A, B, and C has increased and the Commission approvals usually occur well after the hangar owner transfer has taken place. Due to the frequency of reassignments and the time between quarterly Airport Commission meetings, staff recommend the Airport Manager be given authority to approve assignments for hangar rows A, B, and C.

Recommendation: Staff recommends the Airport Commission authorize the Airport Manager to approve lease assignments for hangars on hangar rows A, B, and C with there being exceptions for unique cases regarding these hangars.

FISCAL IMPACT:

None.

BACKGROUND:

Lease reassignments are a common practice at CIC for the hangars in rows A, B, and C. At present the Airport Commission authorizes any lease assignment with terms up to fifteen (15) years for all hangars. The approval from the Airport Commission on many assignments and new leases is a necessity, while there are some that have been deemed as unnecessary and routine. Lease assignments for hangars in rows A, B and C fall into the routine category. There has been some desire to remove the burden and streamline the process of these routine lease assignments from the Airport Commission to allow the approval to be completed by the Airport Manager. The authorization for the Airport Manager to approve these routine lease assignments would allow the lease approval to more closely coincide with the sale or new occupancy of these before mentioned hangars.

DISCUSSION:

In previous years any new lease assignment for hangars in rows A, B, and C approval has come from the Airport Commission through the use minute orders. Staff and Commissioners have realized a need for the approval of these lease assignments to occur more in line with hangar change in ownership or occupancy.

On 11-3-20 Council adopted the Airport Commission's updated lease policy 90-16 recommendation. Section 5. H. gives the Airport Manager authority to approve leases having a term of one year or less prior to receiving Commission approval. Due to the routine nature and high frequency of reassignments of portable non-permanent hangers located in rows A, B, and C, it's common for a tenant to transact a reassignment prior to the next quarterly Commission meeting. Therefore, staff recommend the Airport Commission grant the Airport Manager authority to transact assignments for rows A, B, and C as long as they're in conjunction with the lease policy. Lease policy 90-16 can be amended to reflect the Airport Commission's recommendation.
