AR 13-19 (GPK/Hallmark) - Carriage Park Apartments, Northeast corner of Bruce Road and E. 20th Street, APN 018-390-020 - A proposal to develop a new apartment complex on a vacant 7.1 acre site involving the construction of eight apartment buildings, containing a total of 141 dwelling units and creating a gross density of approximately 18 dwelling units per acre. The site is located on land designated Medium-high Density Residential on the General Plan diagram and in the R3 Medium High Density Residential zoning district. This project is within the scope of the Doe Mill Ridge/Warfield Lane EIR that was certified by the City of Chico in 1992. In accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15162, no subsequent environmental review is required.

At the request of the applicant, this project is being continued to a future date in order to complete the application with all required information and drawings. The project will be re-noticed when the new public hearing date is determined.

- 3.2 AR 13-14 (The Printed Image) 2209 Park Avenue; APN 005-480-006 Proposed partial demolition of unoccupied warehouses and new construction of a 21,300 sq. ft. building for light manufacturing use. The site is located on land designated Industrial Office Mixed Use on the General Plan diagram and in the IOMU (Industrial Office Mixed Use) zoning district. The site is also located within "The Wedge" Opportunity Site identified by the General Plan. This project is categorically exempt from environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, Section15332 (In-Fill Development Projects). - 3.3 Conceptual Architectural Review for Village Green (Leete/Brown) - A single-family residential subdivision and planned development permit located at the southeast corner of Idyllwild Circle and Sierra Sunrise Terrace, APN 018-360-002 - Preliminary review only of a subdivision to create 46 single-family home lots on a vacant 5.7 acre site, and a planned development permit to authorize architectural concepts of homes, decorative privacy walls, a The project creates a gross density of approximately 7.1 units park amenity, and landscaping. per acre. The applicant is seeking Board input only on architectural concepts related to the The applicant will return for formal Board review and planned development permit. recommendation at a subsequent noticed public hearing. The site is located on land designated Medium Density Residential on the General Plan diagram and in the R2 Medium Density Residential zoning district. The level of environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) will be determined after the required development applications have been submitted.
