# 1. <u>UPDATE ON THE APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FROM PG&E INNOVATOR PILOT GRANT FOR AN ENERGY CONSERVATION OUTREACH PROGRAM</u>

At its 11/2/09 meeting, the Task Force formed an Ad-Hoc Committee, consisting of Task Force members Buckley, Dobbs, Stallman, Wolf, McNall, Pushnik and Schwab, to develop a proposal for a grant application for PG&E's Innovators Pilot Program to help market energy conservation and efficiency to residents and businesses. The Ad-Hoc Committee met several times and has developed an abstract of the grant proposal. A copy of the abstract is attached as Exhibit "A" and the Committee will provide a report to the Task Force on this project.

- a. <u>United Nations Climate Change Conference Candlelight Vigil</u> The United Nations annual Climate Change Conference will be held in Copenhagen, Denmark from December 7-18, 2009.   <u>Energy Conservation Measures Required upon Resale</u> The City Manager has requested that the proposed municipal code revisions be presented to the formal Board of the Chico Association of Realtors and to the North Valley Property Owners Association.
- **c.** <u>Update on Preparation of the Climate Action Plan</u> Staff will provide an update on the progress in developing a draft Climate Action Plan.
