



NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC HEARING

PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE INPUT FROM THE COMMUNITY ON THE REDISTRICTING OF THE CITY OF CHICO COUNCIL DISTRICTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Chico, will hold a special public hearing on Tuesday, March 29th, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. to receive additional input from the community on the redistricting of the City of Chico Council districts originally established in 2020.

At its meeting of March 15th, 2022, the Council approved five maps to be moved forward for further consideration and extended the time for citizens to submit additional maps until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 21st. At the Council's direction, the Demographer was asked to make modifications to Demographer Map 4 and 5 and Public Submission Map #2. The City of Chico is continuing its process of redistricting following the completion of the 2020 U.S. Census. Redistricting, which occurs approximately every ten years, is defined as election district lines being redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population. Redistricting is performed following the publication of data from the U.S. Census, a survey conducted about the nation's population and economy every 10 years.

The agenda for the March 29th meeting will be posted on Tuesday, March 22nd. All redistricting information and maps can be found on the City's website. All interested persons are invited to attend the meeting in person to provide input at the scheduled public hearing.
