

Chico 2022 Redistricting Kit Instructions:

- Population in each of the 7 Districts must be between 14,001 and 15,475. Note: Try to under populate the district where you place the Chapman annexation by 1,000 people from the media. U.S. Census has not updated this area to be a part of Chico so it will not come up on a GIS. We will add in the Chapman annexation data after submission.
- Each population area or block group is notated by an assigned number between 1-90. Below its assigned number, the population of the block group is shown.
- There will also be an excel spreadsheet you can download that has the population numbers and citizen voting age population numbers broken down by block group.
- You can use the sheet and block groups as a reference to add the information.
- If you wish, you can use the Assignments tap, highlighted in yellow to assign the district you would like to see each block group assigned to. When submitted the demographer will use this information to create the map.
- Please use thick dark-colored pen to draw your map. Then submit it by scanning and emailing to RedistrictingEmails@chicoca.gov or you can hand deliver your map to the City Clerk's office at City Hall.
- If you just wish to color in a specific area you wish to see remain in one district, you can do so. This input will be taken into consideration in the maps the demographer does.
