Commerce Court / Westfield Lane Connection Project

### REPORT IN BRIEF:

The Meyers Industrial Area, located in southwest Chico, is comprised of more than 125 businesses. There is only one ingress/egress from Park Avenue into the industrial area which is via Meyers Street. Concerns of safety by the business owners and employees have recently been brought to staff's attention. Should an emergency occur, such as a fire, cars could potentially be blocked from exiting the area, thus having to leave on foot.

Currently, Westfield Lane is accessible from Park Avenue; however, it dead ends at Commerce Court which is located within the industrial area. There is a fence that divides Westfield Lane and Commerce Court.

Staff has prepared a conceptual design to connect Westfield Lane and Commerce Court, thereby allowing a second access point to the Meyers Industrial Area. The proposed design would involve roadway reconfiguration and right of way acquisitions from properties on Westfield Lane.

## Recommendations:

Director of Public Works - Engineering, Leigh Ann Sutton, recommends that the Committee forward a recommendation to the City Council to consider future funding for this project.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The costs associated with the design, right of way acquisition, and construction of the proposed project, including consultant services and staff time, is approximately \$1,560,000. A Supplemental Appropriation request would be prepared should the Committee recommend forwarding to City Council for consideration and receive final approval.

### **BACKGROUND:**

As part of the Southwest Chico Neighborhood Improvement Plan, adopted on December 2, 2008, the City Council allocated funds to be spent on various projects (Capital Project 50140) within the Southwest Chico Neighborhood. With Council approval in 2011, the City acquired a portion of the private alleyway (now Westfield Lane) to allow for a future secondary access from Park Avenue into the Meyers Industrial Area. Currently, the Meyers Industrial Area is only accessible by a single street (Meyers Street).

### **ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:**

The project has been determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to section 15301.C (Existing Facilities). The project consists of reconstructing and upgrading an existing paved alley into a new standard street. The project is consistent with the General Plan and consistent with the adopted Southwest Neighborhood Plan. Traffic circulation impacts are expected to be minimal and will not affect level of services.

### DISCUSSION:

A secondary access into the Meyers Industrial Area would improve vehicle circulation and diminish safety concerns related to emergency situations within the industrial area.

In order to make the connection, Westfield Lane would need to be brought up to City street standards. The estimated costs to develop and construct this project are \$1,560,000. There are no funds currently programmed for this project nor are there potential grant opportunities to address the needs in the near future. The project is part of the General Plan circulation element, and could result in a reduction of Vehicle Miles Traveled.
