Vandalism

******* Update *******

On 03/11/19 at approximately 0900 hours, Chico Police arrested Cameron Lacy for the damage to multiple vehicles in the area of Cinder Creek Drive and Ruby River Drive on 02/23/19. During the investigation, officers learned Lacy had damaged 14 vehicles in that neighborhood. Lacy was arrested for felony vandalism and transported to the Butte County Jail for booking.

On 02/23/19 at approximately 0808 hours, Chico Police Officers responded to the 3100 block of Cinder Creek Drive, regarding damage to multiple vehicles in the area. Officers learned 12 vehicles had been vandalized. Most of the damage to the vehicles consisted of tires which had been punctured. Security images from one of the homes indicated one male suspect was responsible for the damage. The cost to repair the damage resulting from the vandalism was thousands of dollars.
