### **Train vs Pedestrian collision**

**Chico, CA** – On 4/21/19 at 2:52 pm, Chico Police were called to the area of the railroad tracks and West 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue. A citizen reported a female had been struck by a train and was injured. Chico Fire personnel and Butte Medics also responded and treated the female. The female had been walking on the railroad tracks when she was struck by a train that was travelling northwest through Chico. The female sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. The train was stopped immediately after the collision and traffic was impacted on West East Avenue and West Lindo Avenue for approximately 90 minutes.
