FATAL VEHICLE VERSUS PEDESTRIAN COLLISION

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Chico, CA – On 10/26/19, at 7:14 a.m., The Chico PD Dispatch Center received a 911 call that a vehicle had collided with a pedestrian near the corner of Main Street and E. 9th Street near downtown Chico. Chico Fire, Butte County EMS and Chico Police arrived on scene and found the pedestrian on the ground and unresponsive. The pedestrian was transported to Enloe Medical Center where he succumbed to injuries he sustained in the collision.

The Chico Police Department's Major Accident Investigation Team (M.A.I.T.) responded to the scene and conducted a thorough investigation of the incident. During the investigation, E. 9th Street between Main Street and Wall Street was closed for approximately four hours. At this point in the investigation, impairment does not appear to be a factor on the part of the driver of the vehicle. It is unknown at this time if it was a factor on the part of the pedestrian. The identification of the pedestrian is withheld pending confirmation and notification of next-of-kin.
