Domestic Dispute / Vehicle Pursuit

On 10-27-19 at approximately 1633 hours, CPD officers responded to a reported domestic dispute on the 3100 block of the Esplanade. A female caller reported her boyfriend had damaged her vehicle and taken the vehicle from her without her permission. The female also indicated her boyfriend may have a warrant for his arrest. As Chico Police responded to the location, an officer spotted the vehicle driving southbound on Highway 99. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, but the driver would not stop. The vehicle was pursued by Chico Police southbound on Highway 99. The California Highway Patrol was contacted and requested to take over the pursuit as it got further outside of Chico. The pursuit was turned over to California Highway Patrol officers, who maintained the pursuit until the vehicle stopped on Midway, south of Durham. The driver was taken into custody and booked at the Butte County Jail. The driver was identified as Timothy Jayne. Jayne was charged with two felony warrants, one misdemeanor warrant, felony evading a peace officer, driving under the influence of alcohol/drugs, vehicle tampering, vehicle theft, and resisting arrest. There were no injuries resulting from this pursuit.
